Jan. 5. Having finished 1205, made an attempt to clear up exterior walls. But the "NE" corner is so cut by Muslem burials and the outer walls on "W", "N" and "E" so destroyed by sebakh-digging that the lines can only be surmised. This is especially disturbing on the "N" where an older heavy wall lies unconnected.

Jan. 6. Locals -- 133  
12th day  
of work. Work on (1) B 200  
(2) B 502  
(3) B 700

- (1) B 200  
Jan. 6. I worked on plan of B 200 the small rock-cut temple of Tirhaqa "N" of the larger rock-cut temple. Had a man clear up floor and found traces of several doors. The remarkable point is that the door sockets instead of having round holes, had square holes with iron posts (decayed). See notes.

- (2) B 502  
Jan. 7. Laying RR and preparing to attack 502 "SE" quarter both inside and on "S".
- (3) B 700  
Jan. 7. Removed palm capital in doorway 701 to 702 and removed underlying debris.
- (4) B 1200  
Cut a number of trenches "E" of 1200 finding gebel (red sand) at about 40 cm down (dirty surface debris). At one point cut a hole 100x100 cm to a length of ca. 200 cm.
