- ③ At 900 continued clearing towards river. Here there are some superimposed latowalls with floors about 100-120 cm above the floor of room 904

In room 901 removed the debris down to red sand. In the GU quarter and along the E. wall this was debris of decay with a weather surface about as a level with the top of the second foundation course (2 f-c.). Some col. drums were in this. The debris in the rest of the room had been disturbed in modern times, ~~the~~ and contained a number of the col. drums. Under the two col. of which parts remain standing runs a stone floor. These two appear to belong to the earlier building.

I am unable at present to trace any continuation of this building longwise; but the older building of mud brick under 800 has the same orientation.
