The chapel appears to have had three chambers. Previous excavators (Europeans?) have been rooting around in a futile aimless way. [At IV there is a stone of the chapel inscribed "PÜCKLER MUSKAU"]

(9) Carried trenches a-d W of Building 700 to hard black "gebel". All showed the same strata. The surface, uneven and covered with stones, results from weathered <a href="sebah">sebah</a><sup>28</sup> digging. [DRAWING] The strata are everywhere the same,--above a layer of 30-50 cm of <a href="sebah">sebah</a> bearing dirt (potsherds) the decay of an ancient building; then about 100-120 cm of red sand, natural detritus from Gebel Barkal; then a hard bank of alluvial mud. After finishing a-d, resumed work on a'-d'
